MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is made on this 1st day of February in the Year 2021
BETWEEN

DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY, Silapathar Science College, Silapathar, Assam- 787059.

And

DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY, Silapathar Science College, Silapathar, Assam- 787059.

1. Parties: This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is made and entered into by and between the Department of Botany, Silapathar Science College, Silapathar, Assam-787059 and the Department of Chemistry, Silapathar Science College, Silapathar, Assam-787059.

2. Purpose: The purpose of this MOU is to establish the terms and conditions under which both the parties to engage in an effort to promote academic and research activities by expanding the mutual relationship.

3. Responsibilities: Under this MOU will be identified through consultation between the two parties. Department of Botany and Department of Chemistry, Silapathar Science College, agrees to provide technical assistance in terms of teaching, research and training between the departments to carry out activities such as training, awareness seminar/conference/workshop etc.

The aim of the agreement is to achieve the goal or scope of the activities of both institutions for a period 5 years following signature of this MoU, joint research, training and capacity building to address research opportunities in the India. The mutual benefits of both parties and in investigating funding sources to realize these opportunities.

4. General Provisions:

i) **Amendment:** Either party may request changes to this MOU. Any changes, modifications, revisions or amendments to this MOU which are mutually agreed upon by and between the parties to this MOU shall be incorporated by written instrument, and effective when executed and signed by all parties to this MOU.

ii) **Period of Validity:** This agreement shall be initially valid for five year from the date of signing the agreement and to be renewed subsequently by mutual consent of both the parties.

iii) **Extension and Renewal.** The Participants may extend or renew this MOU by agreement in a written amendment signed by each Participant's authorized signatory.

iv) **Implementation:** Each Department shall designate a Cooperative Officer to develop and coordinate specific activities or programs. The terms of such mutual assistance and the necessary budget for each specific program and activity that is to be implemented under the terms and conditions of this MoU shall be discussed and agreed, and written into an agreement prior to the initiation.

v) **Arbitration:** Any dispute arising with regard to any aspect of this Agreement shall be settled through mutual consultations and agreements by the parties to the Agreement.

vi) **Termination:** Both the parties have right to terminate this agreement in case the Department fails to provide services successfully or violates any of clause mentioned in the MOU or exploits the students or misuse the partnership. However the termination of MOU needs at least 3 months written notification.

This MoU shall become effective on the date that it is signed by both parties and shall be valid for 5 years until it will terminated by any of the parties.

Any changes in to this MoU shall be subject to the written consent of both parties.

5. Article 1:

1.1. The MOU include activities or programs offered at either department that will portion to the nurturing and development of the mutual relationship between the departments.

1.2. The department may also be offer the other department opportunities such as teaching, trainings, research, exchange of faculty and students, and staff development with collaborative relationship.

1.3. Promoting long and short – term staff and student exchanges in work-shops, seminars, conferences, leadership programs and other academic activities with adequate financial support.

1.4. To receive higher secondary students, undergraduate, post graduate and research students of the partner department during the study period or under internship training period. Also carry out joint academic research activity and continuing education programs by exchange information relating to developments in teaching, student development.

1.5. Sharing of information and guidance for each of the department regarding the new facilities, research, publications, journals, books, library materials and educational resources of the other department needs yearly review to evaluate the past activities and to work out new ideas for future development.

1.6. Enhancing the capacity of the two departments to carry out relevant research and to secure the required external funding for same.

6. Article 2:

2.1. This agreements concerning any program shall provide details concerning the specific commitments made by each party and shall not become effective until they have been reduced to writing and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties. The scope of the activities under this agreement shall be determined by the funds regularly available by the both parties. The financial assistance as may be obtained by either party from external sources.

2.2. This MOU is not binding on either department but is proposed to facilitate discussions relative, but not limited, in the areas of cooperation. Specific activities and programs implemented under authority of this MOU shall be subject to availability of funds and the approval of each department authorized representatives, and it may include joint educational, cultural, and research activities, exchange of faculty members, lectures.

2.3. Specific funding allocations for the exchange of faculty, staff, and students may be carried out as a result of this MOU each Participant shall be responsible for expenses incurred by its employees under this MOU.

2.4. It is recognized and understood that this MOU is subject to all applicable export control laws and regulations pertaining to transfer of certain technical information or items, research materials may require a license from the respective governments of the Participants. No Participant may export or allow the export or re-export of any information or item when to do so would constitute a violation of those laws or regulations.

2.5. Participants should follow adequate safeguard procedures while using human or animal subjects in research, and it require to follow all the applicable laws and policies regarding the use of human and animal subjects, including training of such trainees, faculty, or staff, an institutional review committee, research ethical board.

2.6. All the Participants must give all information/notices under this MOU in writing only. All communications must be sent to the official e-mail address or to such other address designated by the both of the departments.

2.7. Each Department represents that the individuals signing this MOU have the authority to sign on its behalf in the capacity indicated.
