

# Report on Participation in International Women's Day Celebration at Likabali Military Station

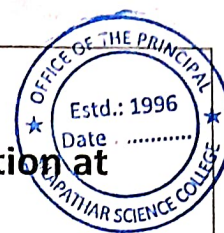

# Report on Participation in International Women's Day Celebration at Likabali Military Station

The International Women's Day Celebration was organized on 8th March 2026 at Likabali Military Station by the 556 Army Service Corps Battalion of the Indian Army. Teachers and girl students from Silapathar Science College actively participated in the programme under the initiatives of DDZACTA, the Women Empowerment Cell, and the National Service Scheme Unit of the college.

A total of 124 participants (12 faculty members and 112 girl students) from the college took part in the celebration. The team was led by Dr. (Mrs.) Pallavi Dutta, Senior Assistant Professor, Department of Botany, who served as the College In-Charge. The group departed from the college campus at 7:30 a.m. in three Army buses arranged by the organizers and reached the venue at around 8:00 a.m.

The programme began with a 5 km Walkathon, which was ceremonially flagged off by Chief Army Officer Ma'am Mona Bakshi along with other officials of the station. The team from the college joined participants from the Army Station and other invitees in the walk conducted within the campus area. The Walkathon aimed to promote women's health, unity, and empowerment in connection with International Women's Day.


Several students from the college performed exceptionally well in the event. From the Higher Secondary Section, Yasodha Goswami, Rita Pegu, and Diya Biswas, and from B.Sc. 6th Semester, Munni Basumatary, were declared winners of the Walkathon and were felicitated by the organizers for their achievement.

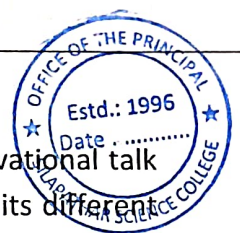

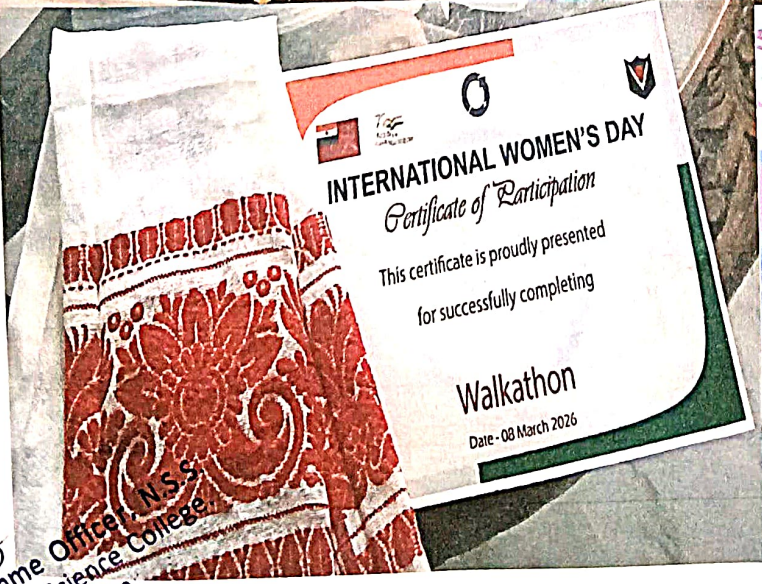
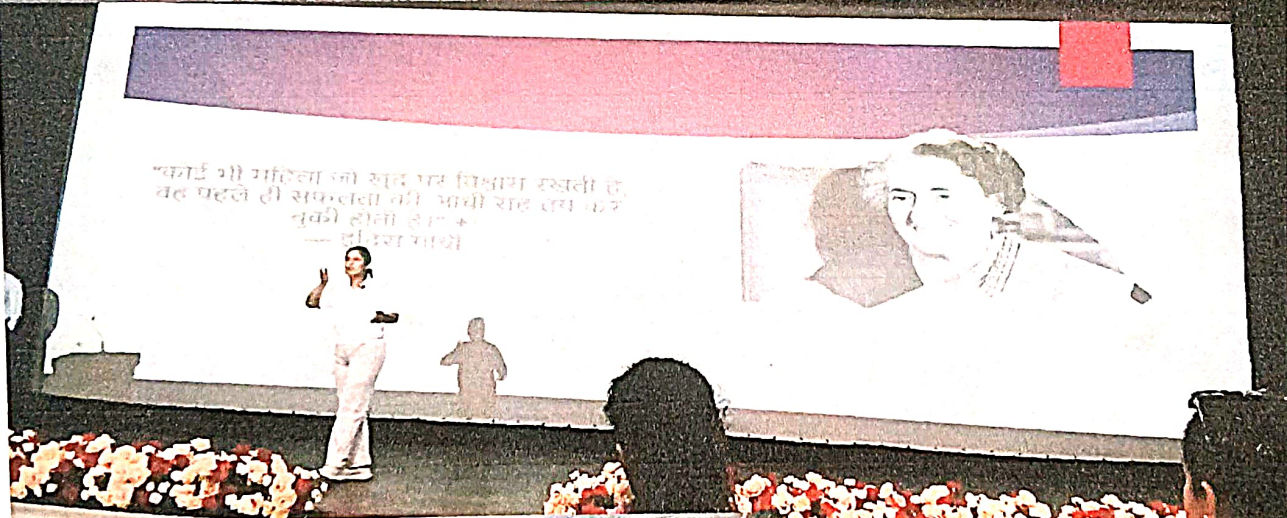
