

REPORT ON THREE-DAY PROGRAMME ON CIRCLE LEVEL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT EXERCISE

(DATED : 19TH, 20TH, 21ST JANUARY, 2026)



A three-day long programme on Circle Level Emergency Management Exercise (EMEx) was successfully organized by the Sissiborgaon Revenue Circle in collaboration with the Fire and Emergency Service and NSS Unit of Silapathar Science College (SScC), Amritpur, Silapathar. The programme was held at the campus of Silapathar Science College. It aimed to enhance awareness, preparedness, and coordination among various stakeholders in managing disaster situations effectively.

Day 1: Technical Session (19.01.2026)

The programme commenced with a technical session on coordination for response and relief management, conducted by Mr. Jagdish Bhattacharya. He elaborated on the importance of timely response, inter-departmental coordination, and effective communication during disaster situations. The session was interactive, where he asked questions related to disaster management, encouraging participants to actively engage and test their knowledge. NSS Volunteers from Silapathar Science College actively participated in the session.

Day 2: Mock Drill Preparation (20.01.2026)

On the second day, a preparatory session for the mock drill on earthquake disaster management was conducted by Mr. Soneshwar Rajbonshi, along with SDRF staff and NSS Volunteers from Silapathar Science College. Participants were trained on safety measures, rescue techniques, evacuation procedures, and team coordination. The session focused on building practical skills and readiness to handle real-life emergencies.

Day 3: Mock Drill Exercise (21.01.2026)

The final day witnessed a full-scale mock drill exercise conducted in the field at the campus of Silapathar Science College based on an earthquake scenario. The exercise involved active participation from NSS Volunteers of Silapathar Science College, SDRF (State Disaster Response Force), NDRF (National Disaster Response Force), Fire Department personnel, and medical teams. The drill demonstrated rescue operations, first aid response, evacuation, and coordination among different agencies, providing hands-on experience to all participants.

Conclusion

The three-day EMEx programme proved to be highly informative and practical. It enhanced the preparedness and confidence of the participants in dealing with emergency situations. The active involvement of NSS Volunteers from Silapathar Science College and the collaborative effort of all departments ensured the success of the programme and highlighted the importance of teamwork in disaster management.

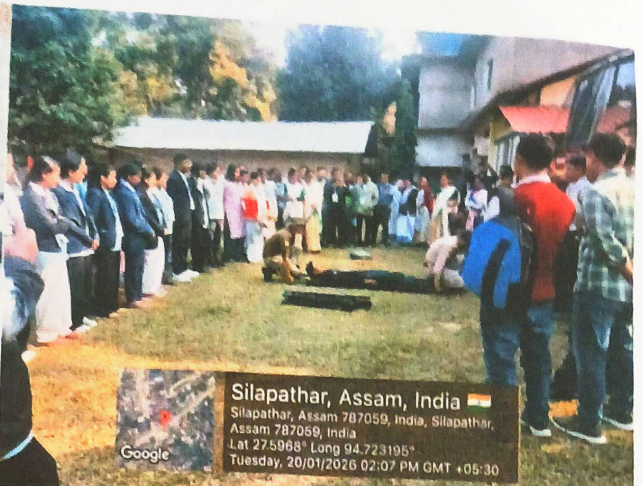
