## **CONCEPT NOTE**

Traditionally people in the riverine environment prefers to settle down close to the river as it provides certain easy opportunities and facilities for sustenance. The river courses are used as transport routes and also natural fishing grounds. The Subansiri River and its resources are the lifelines of huge number of people in the downstream of the river covering both Lakhimpur and Dhemaji districts of Assam. It is the tributary of the mighty river Brahmaputra. The resources collected from the river and the river banks are mostly consumed domestically. As the economy of the area is dominated by agriculture, the inhabitants have naturally developed a close linkage with the local water resources - the river and the wetlands. The floodplains of the river and the wetland fringes provide suitable lands for agriculture and livestock rearing. A huge number of fishermen depends on the river and the river resources. The fishermen play an important role in economic development and resource mobilization of the area.

The main objective of the seminar is to access the different issues and status of fishermen of Subansiri river and to find out ways and policies as to how can enhance their livelihood from the miserable situation. The seminar is expected to encourage thoughts-views and develop policies for livelihood enhancement of the fishermen of this area.
