

A field visit to Dimow under the guidance of Dr. Chandana Shyam (trip in-incharge), Dr. Pabitra Sarmah (HOD), Ms. Lolita Doley and Parag Sonowal (Lab. Bearer) Department of Zoology was carried out for the B.Sc. 3rd semester students of Zoology (Major) on the 18th November, 2024. A Vermifarm of Shantipur Village, Dimow were visited. The half-day trip was carried out in partial fulfillment of the requirements of the B.Sc. 3rd semester in Zoology. The purpose of the trip was to provide experiential learning and exposures to students which will help them to have a better understanding of what they have learnt in their course.

On the 18th November 2024, around 9:30 am we left the college and the group reached the Vermifarm located at Shantipur Village, Dimow at 10:30 am. The visit started with a lecture on "Vermicomposting "delivered by Dr. Pabitra Sarmah (HOD). The lectures were followed by the poster viewing where there was an interaction between the students, the faculty of the department of Zoology and Mr. Budheswar Pamey, the owner of the Vermifarm. After the introduction, Mr. Budheswar Pamey gave a detailed explanation on the "Vermicomposting" how he managed the Vermifarm and sales the vermicompost to the cities like Along, Pasighat etc. He also shares us the rate of vermicompost (i.e. Rs 12/kg) which is a wholesale rate. He not only sales the vermicompost but he also sales the earthworm at the rate of Rs 1800/KG. After that he shows us, what equipment he uses for the harvesting of vermicompost by Earthworms.






