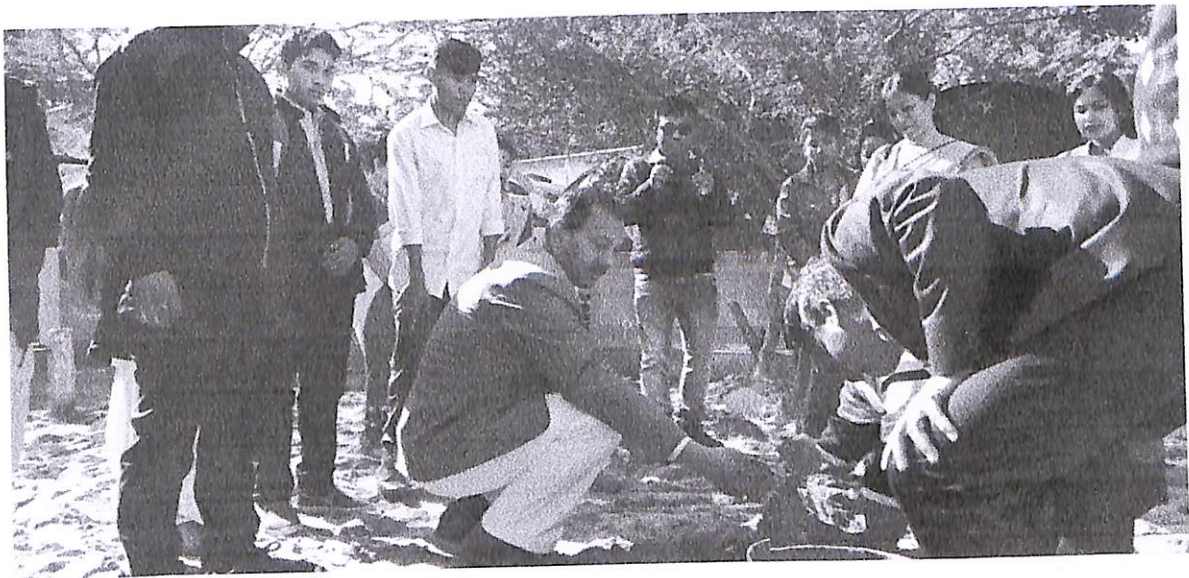

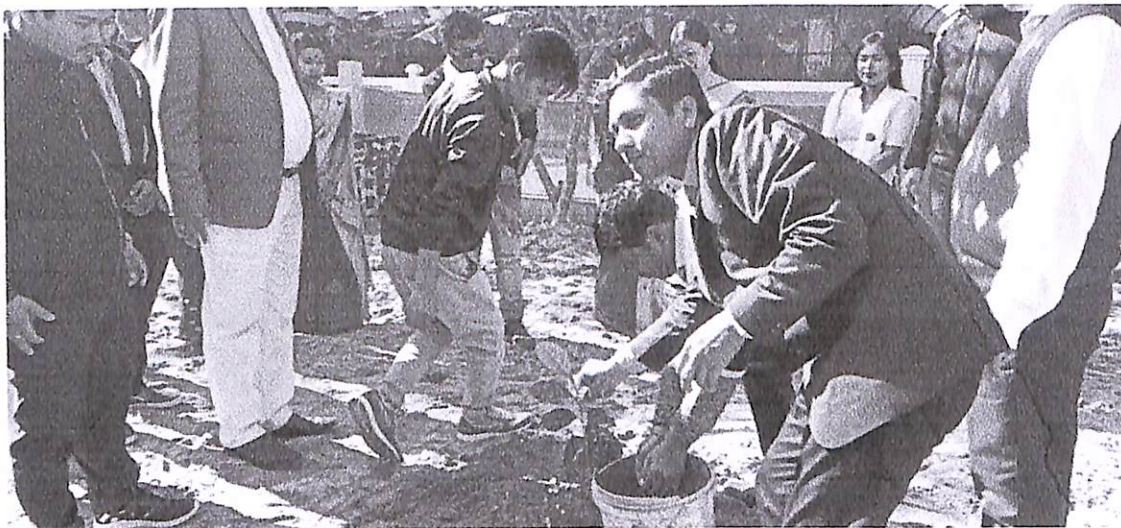

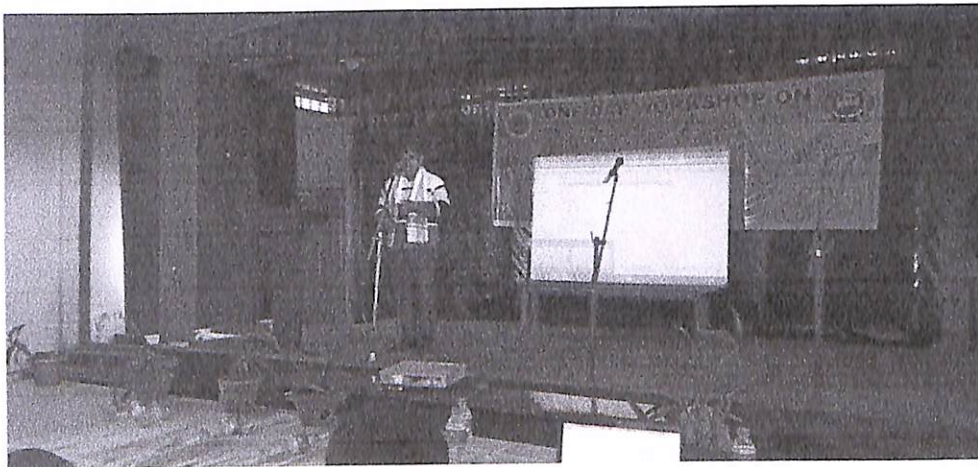

About the Society: Orchid Society of Assam (OSA) is a registered society, registered under Assam Government and the Head office is situated at Silapathar Science College, Silapathar from 2018. The society was started with the aim to organize orchid lovers, conservators, young researchers and scientist working in orchids to be an organization. At present the society consists of 50 members from Assam & Tamilnadu. Presently OSA has established an orchidarium where more than 150 species of wild orchids are under the conservation. The District Agricultural Department of Assam have provided 1200 *Dendrobium sonia* saplings from Thailand.

About the Event: Orchids are one of the largest groups of flowering plants belonging to family Orchidaceae and it is distributed all over the world. In India especially North Eastern region and Himalayas has vast genetic resources of orchids. The orchids have a great potential in the field of floriculture, herbal, pharmaceutical and tourism industry of the country. But these resources are declining rapidly due to destruction, degradation and shrinkage of natural habitats and commercial collection. This is the main aim to organize this event which will encourage the conservation process of valuable orchids in natural habitats supplemented with preservation using

modern methods of conservation like in vitro conservation, seed storage and cryopreservation.
